

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated January 28, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is: 138 flights in February 2025, 140 flights in March 2025, and 174 flights in April 2025.

- Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,080 flights in February, 1,221 flights in March, and 1,453 flights in April. These flights have a total available capacity of 237.6k one-way seats for February, 263.4k one-way seats for March, and 305.7K one-way seats for April.
- Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 24 flights in February, and 26 flights per month in March and April. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 1.6K one-way seats for February, and 1.8k one-way seats per month for March and April.

→ **Pacific Islands**


Fiji lost a return service to Port Vila on 15th ,22nd & 23rd February 2025.
