

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated December 29, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ February: 142 flights
 - ~ March: 144 flights
 - ~ April: 174 flights
- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,108 flights in February, 1,246 flights in March, and 1,454 flights in April. These flights have a total available capacity of 245k one-way seats for February, 274.5k one-way seats for March, and 306K one-way seats for April.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 32 flights in February, 34 flights in March, and 35 flights in April. The scheduled services provide a total capacity of 2.7K one-way seats for February, 2.8K one-way seats for March, and 2.9K one-way seats for April.

Australia

➔ There were no significant changes to Fiji's Australian network.

New Zealand

➔ Fiji cancelled services to Auckland on 20 and 27 August, 3, 10, and 12 September 2026, followed by 29 October, 5 November, and 12 November 2026.

United States & Canada

➔ Fiji gained a weekly service to Vancouver, effective between 22 October and 3 December 2026.

Pacific Islands

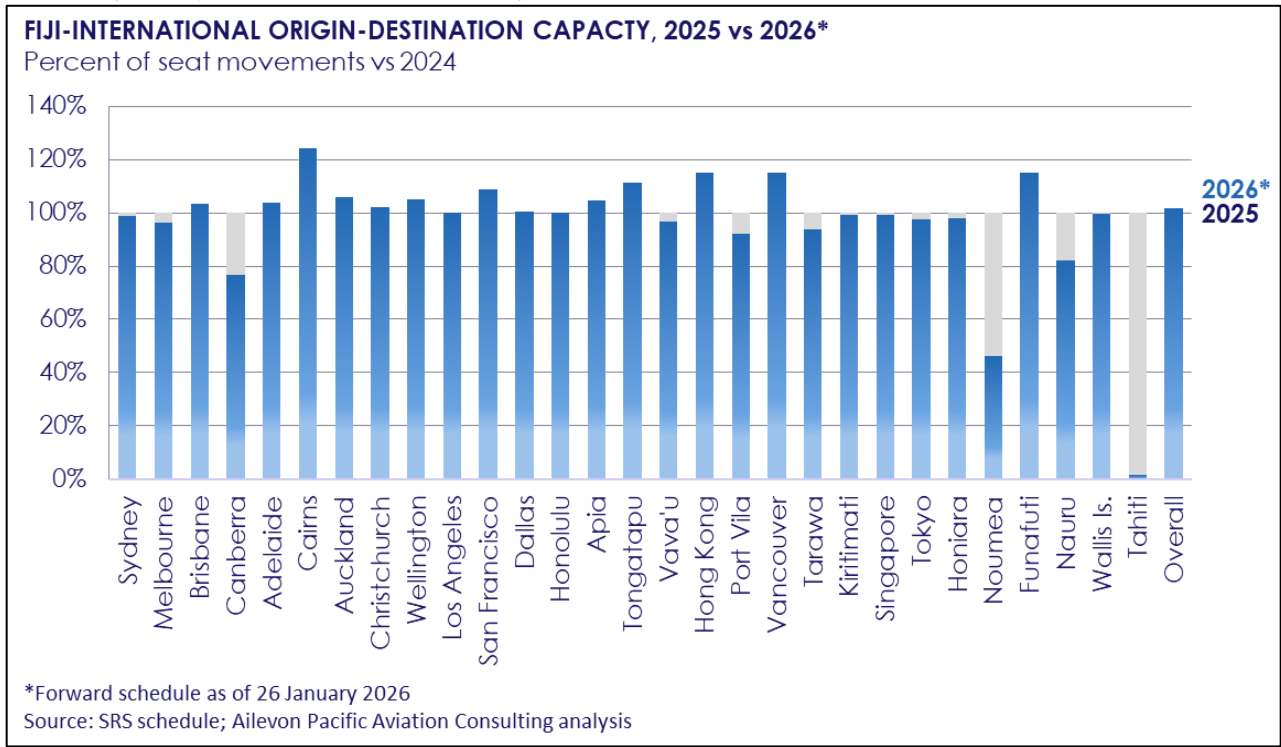
➔ A return service was added to Tongatapu on 13 November 2026.

➔ Fiji lost a return service to Vava'u on 11, 18, and 25 August 2026.
