

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated February 24, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ March: 140 flights
- ~ April: 173 flights
- ~ May: 167 flights

- Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,209 flights in March, 1,451 flights in April, and 1,467 flights in May. These flights have a total available capacity of 262.3k one-way seats for March, 305.1K one-way seats for April, and 312.1k one-way seats for May.
- Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 26 flights per month in March and April, and 28 flights in May. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 1.8k one-way seats per month for March and April, and 1.9K one-way seats for May.

Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

Australia

- Fiji gained a service to Canberra on the 31st May 2025.
- Fiji lost 3 weekly service to Sydney throughout September 2025 and a return service to Brisbane on the 21st August 28th August and 2nd October 2025.

New Zealand

- Fiji gained a weekly service to Christchurch from the beginning of NW 25/26 season until the 8th December 2025. In additional, Fiji gained a weekly service to Wellington in January 2026 and a return service to Auckland on the 20th August, 27th August, 8th September, 15th October & 16th October 2025.

United States & Canada

- Fiji lost a return service to Vancouver on the 16th August 2025 and gained a service on the 11th December 2025 & 25th December 2025

Pacific Islands

- Fiji lost 2 weekly service to Port Vila in the 2nd half of March 2025 & throughout May 2025.
- Fiji gained a service to Tarawa on the 18th, 21st & 25th February 2025. In addition, Fiji had a net gain of a weekly service to Apia in between August & December 2025.
- Fiji lost a weekly service to Tongatapu in September 2025 and gained a weekly flight to Kiritimati in January 2026.


Rest of the world

- Fiji removed 6 return flights to Hong Kong in the 2nd half of August 2025, followed by another 8 return flights in September 2025, 14 in October 2025, 13 in November 2025 & 14 in December 2025.
- In addition, Fiji lost 3 return flights to Singapore in August 2025, 8 in September 2025, 6 in October 2025, 5 in November 2025 and 6 in December 2025.

Percent of seat movements vs 2024




