

## Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated March 31, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ April: 173 flights
- ~ May: 167 flights
- ~ June: 178 flights

- Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,451 flights in April, 1,467 flights in May, and 1,498 flights in June. These flights have a total available capacity of 305.1K one-way seats for April, 312.6k one-way seats for May, and 313.2k one-way seats for June.
- Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 26 flights in April, 28 flights in May, and 24 flights in June. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 1.8k one-way seats for April, 1.9K one-way seats for May, and 1.6K one-way seats for June.

### Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

#### Australia

- Fiji gained two return services to Sydney on 5 July and 12 July 2025.
- Fiji lost four return services to Melbourne in November 2025.

#### New Zealand

- Fiji lost return services to Christchurch on 26 October and 2 November 2025, while Auckland gained return services on 1 January and 5 January 2026.
- Fiji lost three weekly services to Wellington in January 2026.

#### United States & Canada

- Fiji gained a return service to Vancouver on 1 January 2026.

#### Pacific Islands

- Fiji gained a weekly service to Vava'u between August and September 2025, while an additional weekly service to Tongatapu operated from mid-August to the end of September 2025.
- Fiji lost return services to Apia on 23 and 30 August 2025, followed by the loss of a Sunday return service between 1 November and 13 December 2025.
- In addition, Fiji lost a weekly service to Tongatapu throughout November 2025


#### Rest of the world

- Fiji gained additional services to Hong Kong on 25 May, 22 June, 29 June, and 3 August 2025. However, one weekly service was removed in September 2025, followed by the loss of 14 return flights in January 2026.
- Fiji gained a weekly flight to Singapore between 4 September and 9 October 2025, with an additional service added on 8 October 2025.

Percent of seat movements vs 2024




