

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated April 21, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ May: 167 flights
 - ~ June: 177 flights
 - ~ July: 190 flights
- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,467 flights in May, 1,488 flights in June, and 1,666 flights in July. These flights have a total available capacity of 313.6k one-way seats for May, 312.6k one-way seats for June, and 347.8K one-way seats for July.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 28 flights in May, 24 flights in June, and 28 flights in July. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 1.9K one-way seats for May, 1.6K one-way seats for June, and 1.9k one-way seats for July.

Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

Australia

- ➔ Fiji lost multiple Melbourne services, including two flights on 17 August, one flight each on 29 and 31 August, followed by further reductions between October and December

New Zealand

- ➔ Fiji gained 2 return services to Auckland on 2 and 3 January 2026.

United States & Canada

- ➔ Fiji gained a return service to Vancouver on 1 January 2026.

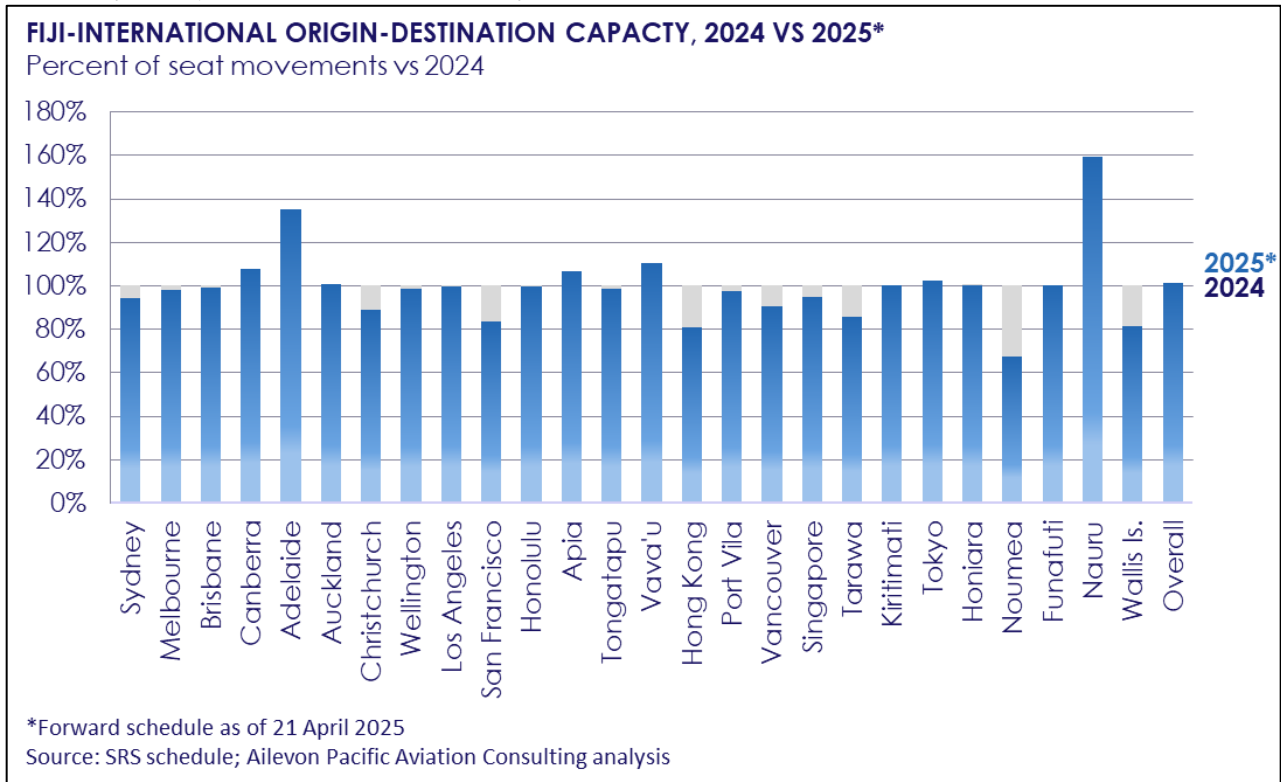
Pacific Islands

- ➔ Fiji lost two weekly services to Port Vila from 23 June 2025 onwards.
- ➔ In addition, Fiji lost return services to Vava'u on 17 and 24 June 2025, and 4 July 2025.

Rest of the world

- ➔ There are no significant changes to Fiji's Asian network.
