

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated April 20th, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ May: 164 flights
- ~ June: 176 flights
- ~ July: 192 flights

- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,406 flights in May, 1,494 flights in June, and 1,688 flights in July. These flights have a total available capacity of 297.7k one-way seats for May, 315.7k one-way seats for June, and 357.6K one-way seats for July.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 35 flights in April, 34 flights in June, and 36 flights in July. The scheduled services provide a total capacity of 2.8K one-way seats for May, 2.7K one-way seats for June, and 3.0K one-way seats for July.

Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

Australia

→ Fiji lost a return service to Brisbane on 9 May, 23 May, 16 June, and 18 June 2026.

New Zealand

→ Fiji lost return services to Auckland from 8 May to 11 May 2026, followed by additional cancellations on 15 May and 17 May 2026. A further seven return flights were removed in June 2026.

United States & Canada

→ Fiji lost a weekly service to Dallas, effective from May 2026 to mid-June 2026.

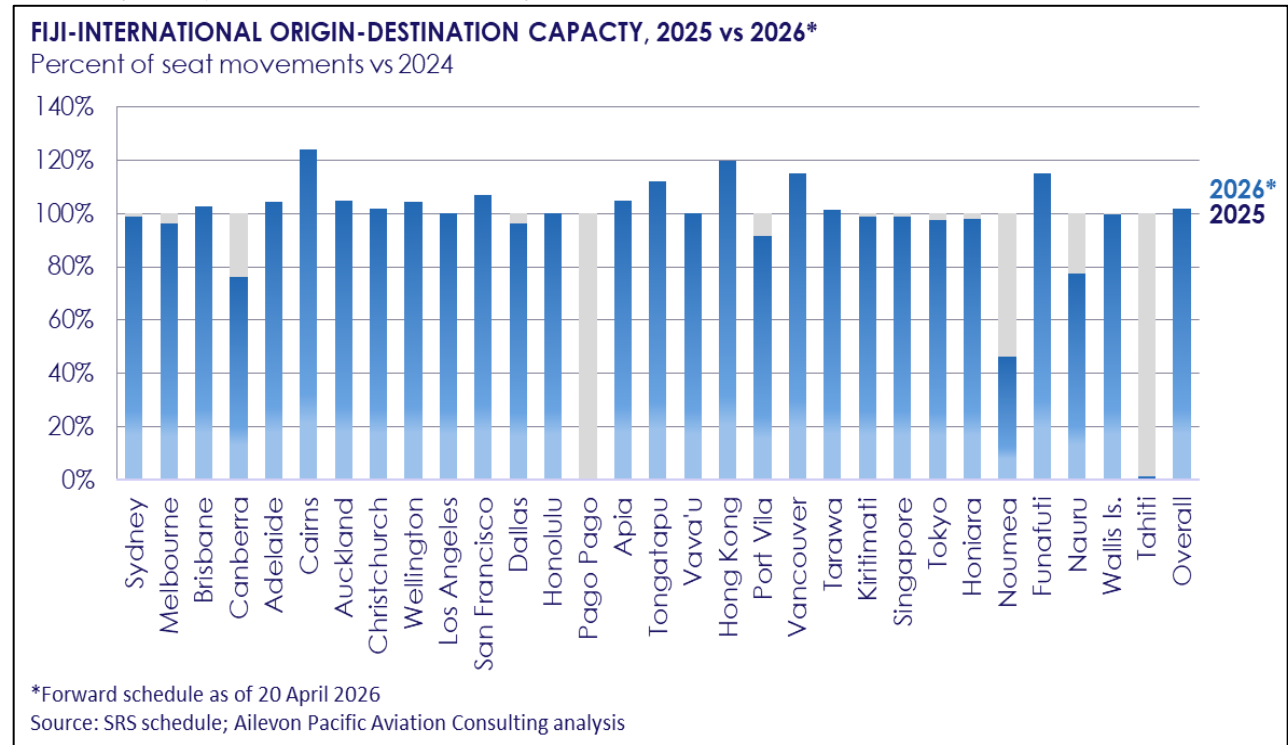
Pacific Islands
