

## Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated May 26, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ June: 177 flights
- ~ July: 190 flights
- ~ August: 183 flights

- Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,492 flights in June, 1,666 flights in July, and 1,592 flights in August. These flights have a total available capacity of 312.8k one-way seats for June, 347.3K one-way seats for July, and 333.1k one-way seats for August.
- Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 24 flights in June, 28 flights in July, and 26 flights in August. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 1.6K one-way seats for June, 1.9k one-way seats for July, and 1.8K one-way seats for August.

#### Australia

- Fiji gained return services on 28 September 2025, 10 September 2025, and 12 October 2025.
- Fiji lost return services on 23 and 30 August 2025.

#### New Zealand

- Fiji recorded a net gain of two return services in December 2025, followed by a net loss of 32 return services in March 2026.

#### United States & Canada

- There are no significant changes to Fiji's North American network.

#### Pacific Islands

- Fiji gained return services to Tongatapu on 28 and 30 June 2025.


#### Rest of the world

Percent of seat movements vs 2024




