

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated May 18th, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ June: 176 flights
- ~ July: 191 flights
- ~ August: 179 flights

- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,492 flights in June, 1,680 flights in July, and 1,581 flights in August. These flights have a total available capacity of 316.7k one-way seats for June, 356.9K one-way seats for July, and 330.7k one-way seats for August.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 34 flights in June, 36 flights in July, and 34 flights in August. The scheduled services provide a total capacity of 2.7K one-way seats for June, 3.0K one-way seats for July, and 2.7K one-way seats for August.

Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

Australia

- Fiji lost return services to Brisbane on 14, 16, 18, and 25 July 2026, and 12, 15, and 17 September 2026, along with a weekly service removed throughout August 2026.
- Fiji lost return services to Sydney on 5, 14, and 17 August 2026, while return services to Melbourne were cancelled on 13, 15, and 16 September 2026.

New Zealand

- There were no significant change to Fiji's New Zealand network.

United States & Canada

- Fiji lost the non-stop service to Dallas, effective 8 September 2026, while a weekly service to San Francisco was added in the 2nd half of September and October 2026.

Pacific Islands

- Fiji lost a return service to Tongatapu on the 7 July 2026.

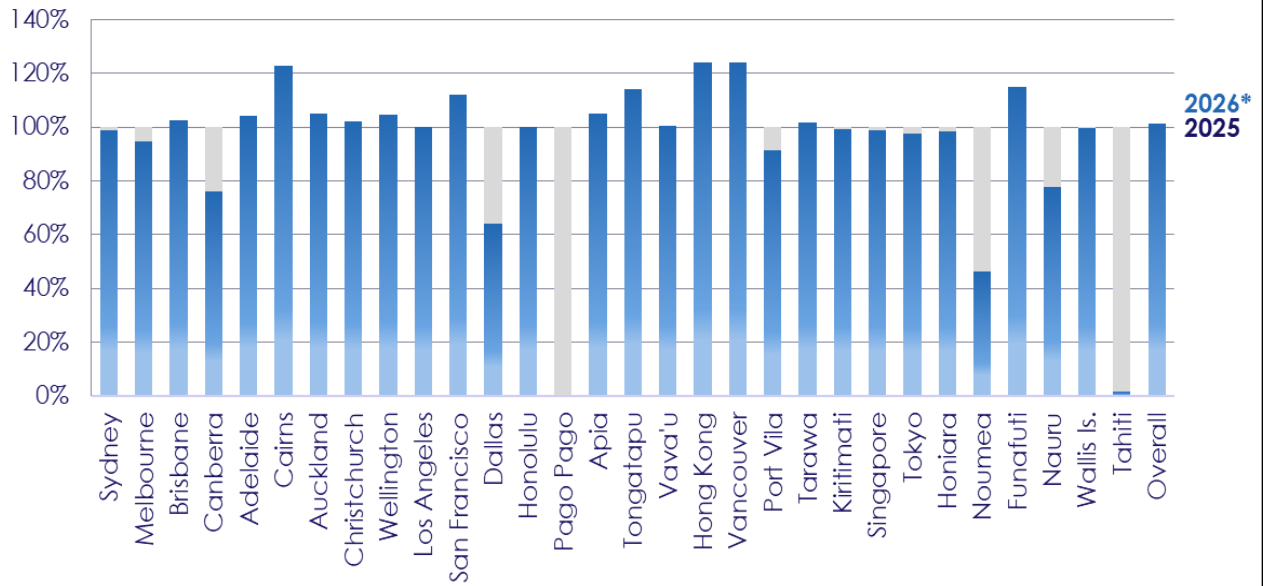
Rest of the World

- Additional weekly service to Hong Kong were added in the 2nd half of October 2026, and from mid-December 2026 until mid-February 2027.

Percent of seat movements vs 2024



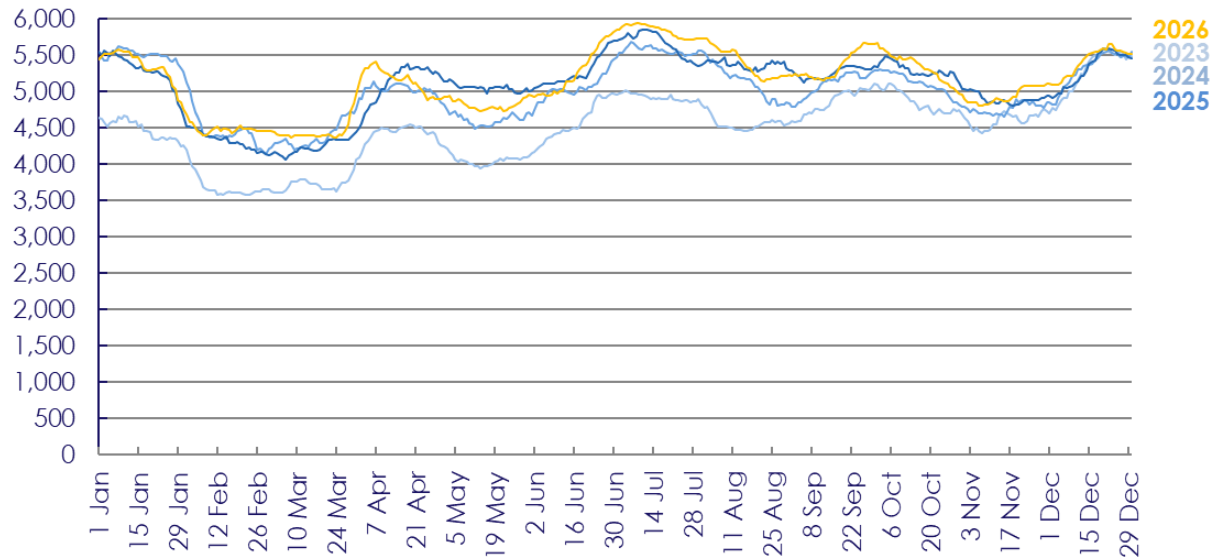
