

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated September 22, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ October: 175 flights
 - ~ November: 166 flights
 - ~ December: 177 flights
- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,519 flights in October, 1,389 flights in November, and 1,535 flights in December. These flights have a total available capacity of 322.3K one-way seats for October, 292.9k one-way seats for November, and 321.6k one-way seats for December.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 36 flights in October and 34 flights per month in November and December. The scheduled flights have a total available capacity of 2.8K one-way seats per month from October to December.

Fiji- International Capacity Snapshot

Australia

- ➔ Fiji lost three weekly return services to Melbourne (Tuesday, Friday and Sunday) between 8 November and 20 November 2025.
- ➔ Melbourne service was cancelled on 1 April 2026, while a Sydney service was removed on 4 April 2026.
- ➔ One additional weekly service was added to Sydney, effective from 5 July 2026.

New Zealand

- ➔ Fiji lost return services to Auckland on 4 October, 10 October and 17 October 2025.
- ➔ Fiji lost a return service to Auckland on 17 January 2026.
- ➔ Two additional weekly services were added from 3 July 2026.

United States & Canada

- ➔ Fiji lost a return service to Vancouver on 9 April 2026.

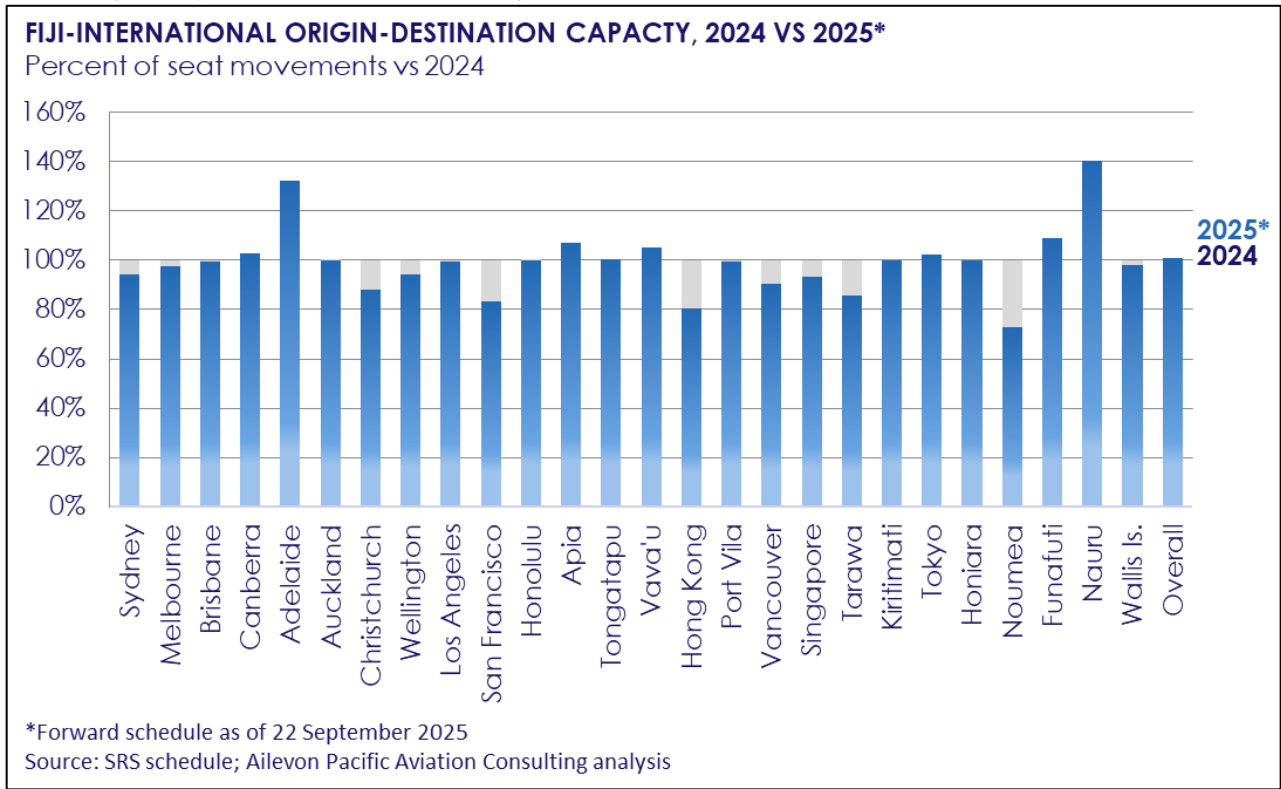
Pacific Islands

- ➔ Fiji lost a return service to Tongatapu on 4 April 2026.
- ➔ Fiji lost two weekly services to Nauru, while gaining one weekly service to Suva, effective from 4 September 2025.

Rest of the world

- ➔ There are no significant changes to Fiji's Asian network.
