

Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated October 20, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ November: 167 flights
- ~ December: 178 flights
- ~ January: 174 flights

- Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,387 flights in November, 1,537 flights in December, and 1,532 flights in January. These flights have a total available capacity of 292.1k one-way seats for November, 322.4k one-way seats for December, and 325.1K one-way seats for January.
- Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 34 flights per month in November and December, increasing to 38 flights in January. The scheduled services provide a total capacity of 2.8K one-way seats per month in November and December, rising to 3.2K one-way seats in January.

Australia

- Fiji lost a return service to Brisbane on 22 November 2025.
- Fiji lost a return service to Sydney on 6 April 2026.

New Zealand

- Fiji lost a return service to Auckland on 16 January 2026.

United States & Canada

- There were no significant changes to Fiji's North American network.

Pacific Islands

- Nadi gained a return service to Tongatapu on 2 April 2026. However, weekly services to Noumea and Tahiti were removed throughout the first half of April 2026.
- Nadi also gained return services on 19 December 2025 and 2 January 2026, with an additional return service to Tongatapu added on 4 April 2026.


Rest of the World

Percent of seat movements vs 2024




