

## Capacity and Performance Summary

As of the schedule dated November 17, the total number of international flights scheduled per week is:

- ~ December: 178 flights
  - ~ January: 174 flights
  - ~ February: 142 flights
- ➔ Nadi Airport is scheduled for a total of 1,537 flights in December, 1,532 flights in January, and 1,106 flights in February. These flights have a total available capacity of 322.8k one-way seats for December, 325.8K one-way seats for January, and 243.9k one-way seats for February.
- ➔ Nausori Airport is scheduled for a total of 34 flights in December, 38 flights in January, and 32 flights in February. The scheduled services provide a total capacity of 2.8K one-way seats for December, 3.2K one-way seats for January, and 2.7K one-way seats for February.

**Pacific Islands**

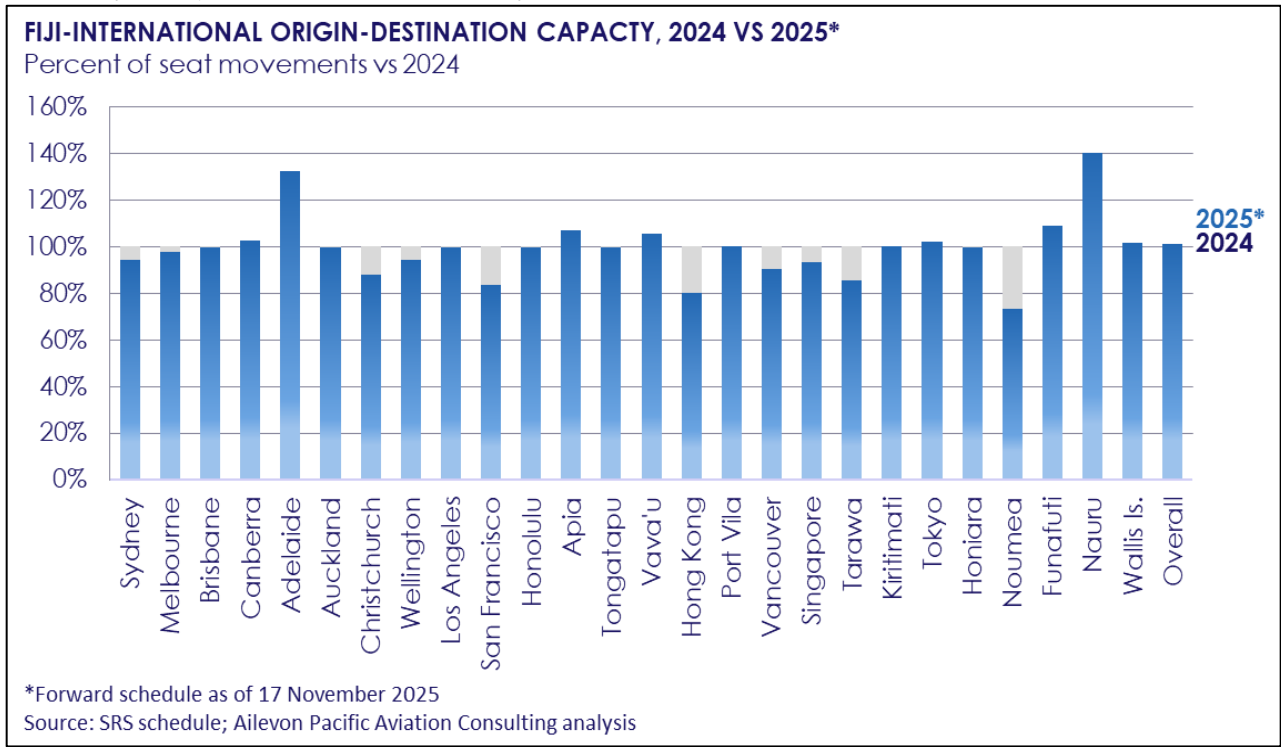
➔ Nadi lost a weekly service to Vava'u throughout August 2026.
